### The Bruckner Recordings of Eduardo Chibas

Conducting an orchestra in a symphony by Anton Bruckner is, I suspect, a dream that many of us share. I will admit that I've swung my arms on many occasions when listening to a particularly convincing recording (but usually it's done with the shades drawn so not to arouse concern amongst my neighbors...) In this newsletter, I will share with you the story of Eduardo Chibas, a fascinating individual who actually lived this dream. Mr. Chibas has conducted two Bruckner symphonies with the Orquesta Sinfonica Venezuela. They are the Symphony # 7 in the orchestra's first performance of the work, and the Symphony # 8 in the Venezuelan premiere. This feat has been well documented with two remarkable CD recordings - ***both of which are now available to you!*** ***Just visit my [store](#) for details.***
